
As indicated in my February 8, 2007 letter regarding MISO having given notice of its intent to terminate the Seams Operating Agreement between the Midwest ISO and MAPPCOR, a meeting of MAPP Members and other stakeholders has been held to discuss issues and concerns with the current agreement and obtain input on improvements that could be made in any new agreement. MAPPCOR intends to continue surveying stakeholders to document issues with the current and any possible future agreement, in anticipation of a future negotiation.

Your letter giving notice of termination of the current agreement did not include specifics with regard to MISO's issues with the current agreement. This makes it difficult for us to adequately begin to address your concerns and to make assignments of appropriate staff to begin work on this effort.

With this correspondence I am requesting that you document in writing your specific and detailed technical / operational concerns and issues regarding the current agreement. Please include detailed examples of when and how the current agreement failed to deliver the intended result, which led to your conclusion that the current agreement should be terminated. It would also be useful for you to provide a detailed analysis of how your proposed remedy to the issue would have cured the situation under the same circumstances.

MAPPCOR is committed to continue the process of exploring ways to continue with a seams operating agreement that meets the needs of our constituents. We look forward to your timely response to this request.
